Organization: (objectives)	No clear plan for organization of material. It is easy to anticipate the material that might be presented next. Well grouped information. 4 points	
Presentation: Verbal, Nonverbal delivery & Aesthetics	Incorrectly pronounces or stumbles on terms, mumbles, no eye contact, poor body language. Power point background not pleasing, text, font, & graphic compete. Transitions are distracting. 0-4 points	Voice is clear and pronounces most terms correctly. Eye contact is maintained most of the time. Adequate enthusiasm and confidence. Well-planned presentation, may be a little difficult to read. A few distractions with font and transitions. 5-9 points	Voice is clear and correct, precise pronunciation of terms. Refrains from "ah" and "um". Eye contact is maintained throughout presentation. Confident and enthusiastic. Presentation format carefully planned. Easy to read and no distracting fonts or transitions. 10 points	
Graphics & Mechanics:	Poor quality graphics and not cited. Graphics do not support the topic. Too much information on slides. Presentation has 3 or more spelling or grammatical errors. 0-1 points	Graphics and/or images somewhat relate to topic. Some are of poor quality. Presentation has no more than 2 spelling or grammatical errors. 2-3 points	Graphics and/or images support and reinforce topic. High quality graphics and/or images. No spelling or grammatical errors. 4 points	
Length: Minimum 28 min. and maximum of 35 minutes	More than 30 seconds outside of the established time limits. 0 points	Student was within 30 seconds of the established time limits. 1 point	Student was within the time set for the presentation guidelines. 2 points	
Overall Impression	Student lacks confidence and does not have a complete understanding of topic. 0-1 points	Student is somewhat confident and understands topic. Mostly relates to current practice and theory. 2-4 points	Student is confident and completely understands topic. The topic relates to current practice and theory. 5 points
