

# SDSRT/ASRT STUDENT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

## REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

- A. The student must be an SDSRT member. This will be verified by the Executive Secretary.
- B. The student must be an ASRT member to be eligible for participation in the ASRT Conference. The ASRT membership will be verified with the ASRT.
- C. The student must be enrolled in a primary school of Radiologic Technology.
- D. The student should have an interest in professional growth and be actively involved in the professional organizations

## GUIDELINES FOR THE SDSRT/ASRT STUDENT INTERNSHIP

- A. The student must agree to participate in state board meetings, emails, and conference calls. These meetings are a combination of teleconferences and face-to-face meetings in which some travel may be involved. Reimbursement for any travel costs will be granted.
- B. The student must attend the SDSRT Annual Convention in the spring and attend the following meetings:
  - a. Pre-Conference Board Meeting
  - b. Business Meetings
  - c. Post-Conference Board Meeting
  - d. Student Paper Presentations
- C. The student interns will have their registration fees waived for the SDSRT annual meeting.
- D. The student must attend and represent South Dakota at the ASRT Educational Symposium and Annual Governance & House of Delegates Meeting. These meetings are out of the state and all travel and lodging will be provided, as well as any stipends which will be determined by the ASRT. The ASRT will outline the necessary requirements to qualify for any travel and lodging arrangements, as well as for stipends. Should the student not meet these requirements the SDSRT **will not** reimburse the student for these expenses.

- E. The student interns are expected to notify the SDSRT board as soon as possible if he or she is unable to attend any meetings in which their attendance is required.
- F. The student interns will be identified as board member interns and recognized at the awards banquet, business meetings, and throughout the SDSRT annual meeting.
- G. The student intern **must** submit a scientific paper or exhibit for possible presentation at the SDSRT Annual Conference.
- H. The student intern **must** submit a written summary of their experience to the SDSRT Chairman of the board within 45 days of the ASRT conference to include what the student felt was beneficial as well as suggestions for improving the learning process of the internship program.
- I. The student intern is required to provide contact information to the board members, and respond in a timely manner to any emails or queries presented to the members of the board.
